## Example Workflow

In this example event, we have created regional meetings in five different cities (New York, Los Angeles, Chicago, Dallas, and Miami) that are connected together with PixelStudio serving as the central hub for production.

### Node: Remote Location

Working with your legacy production partners, PixelStudio provides a hardware node to connect each location into our central hub. The node is remotely managed by our technicians to ensure optimal performance. The team on site connects the node to their audio/visual system and the Internet connection at the venue. Additional equipment can be provided by your production partner to facilitate local breakouts/meetings as needed.

### Hub: Production Control Room

The hub connects the five locations together, and controls the content transmitted and received from each node. The control room also facilitates presentation content, video play-out, switching, mixing, and routing. This means we can customize the experience for each node from a central location, creating a connected event.



### Presenter & Viewer Flexibility

In addition to supporting the experience at each node, PixelStudio can support remote participants via our remote contribution tools and live-streaming capabilities in the control room. This means we are ready to respond and pivot as required by your event.
